Quality education, healthcare, and economic opportunity help women break poverty and discriminatory cycles.

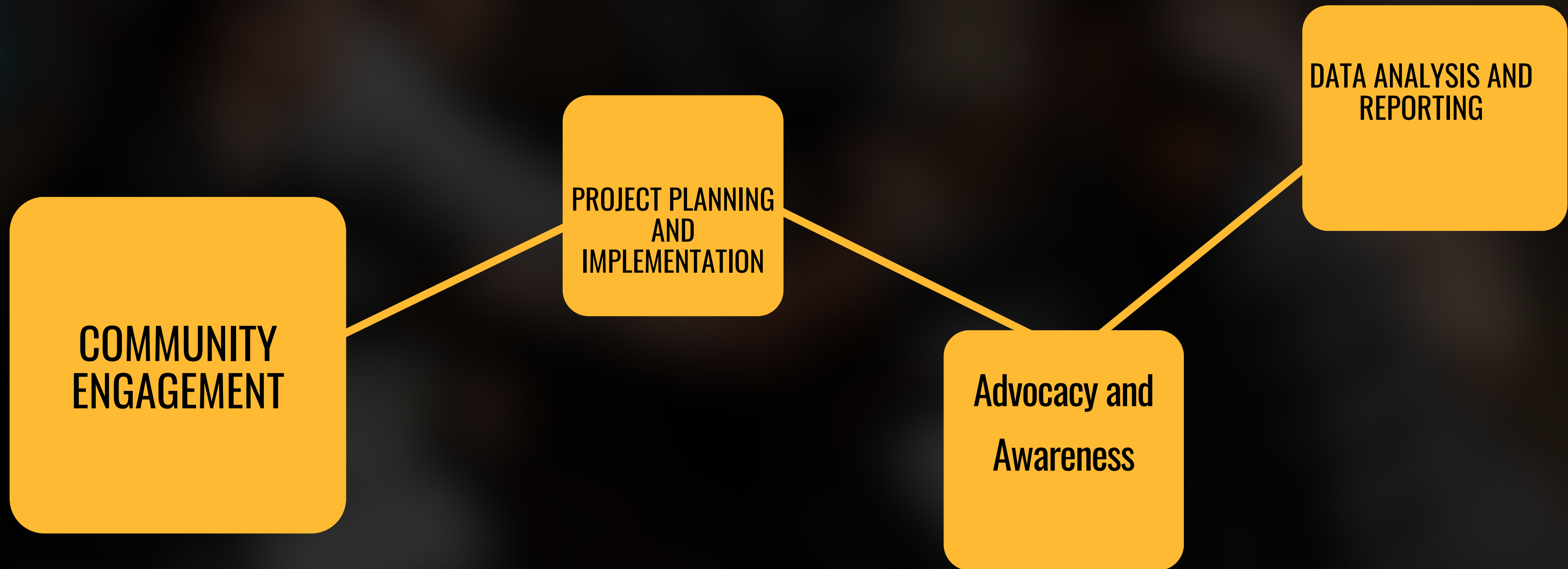
